The wine shows good concentration and complexity on the nose with aromas of Cedar and dried fruits and an elegant richness on the palate</i>	75.00
<b>CÔTE RÔTIE 2004/05</b> <b>Les Jumelles, Paul Jaboulet Aîné, Rhône, France (12.5%)</b> <i>From the steep, sun baked terraces of the 'roasted slope' comes this 100% Syrah wine from the region's most well known producer. Rich, stewed blackberry fruit, hints of spice, leather and black pepper and a long complex finish</i>	49.00	<b>CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET</b> <b>1er CRU MORGEOT 2005</b> <b>Clos de la Chapelle, Domaine Duc de Magenta, Burgundy, France (13.5%)</b> <i>This white wine comes from a small walled 4.6 hectare vineyard owned by the Duc de Magenta. The wine is incredibly rich and complex with flavours of butterscotch, caramel and citrus with hints of smokiness on the finish</i>	65.00	<b>PENFOLDS GRANGE 1999</b> <b>Shiraz Bin 95, South-Eastern Australia (14%)</b> <i>Australia's and Penfold's flagship wine. 90% Syrah with the rest made up of Cabernet Sauvignon, the wine spends 18 months in oak. It shows a great deal of concentration, balance and powerful berry fruit aromas, with blueberry at the core. Tight and structured with ripe tannins shrouded beneath a veil of pungent fruit flavours</i>	135.00
